

Treasurer's Report

It's been another successful year for FoWS, supported by the parents, teachers and friends of Westwood with Iford School.

Fundraising profits of £6,081 are similar to previous years. This was achieved across a number of key popular events such as the Christmas & Summer Fairs, Quiz Night, childrens disco's and Scarecrow Trail.

Funds raised ver the last year have enabled the purchase of a number of enhancements to the hugely successful Westwood Radio, allowing more children to get involved. FoWS have also funded the usual summer activity day, Christmas gifts and leavers tops. In the coming months FoWS have committed to contribute towards the year 5 & 6 residential trip to Simonsbath, a pond dipping platform and the Oral History of Westwood project. FoWS are also planning to contribute funds towards improvements to the Sunflower class outside area (previously Thistle) and some new laptops - the costs of these has yet to be confirmed, so funds have yet to be allocated.

After taking into account a healthy opening balance of £6,215, school purchases, fundraising and admin costs, the bank blance at the end of the year stands at £10,440.

After taking into account all commitments, FoWs have free funds of £6,965.
